AMATEUR -OWNER-HANDLER CLASS

The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class: Entry fee of \$26.00 or \$15.00 as an additional class if the stud dog is entered in a regular class or BOB. For Stud Dog and two of his Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the stud dog. The stud dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed competition, but he MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The GET MUST be entered in one of the regular classes and MUST be indicated as "GET" on the entry form. The stud dog shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee, if the stud dog is entered in another class. The stud dogs must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Brood Bitch Class: Entry Fee of \$26.00 or \$15.00 as an additional class if the brood bitch is entered in a regular class or BOB. For Brood Bitch and two of her Produce. Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, and Produce for Get.

Brace Class: (Two, identical ownership). Entry fee of \$26.00 or \$15.00 as an additional class if also entered in a regular class or BOB. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be a part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for BOB, it must be entered for "Brace Only." In making entries for "Brace Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in a Regular Class or the BOB and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes = "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated - "BraceNo. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

Team: (Four, identical ownership). Same as for Brace except substitute Four Danes, instead of two.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show or which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating the dog is recorded in his name. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration for the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary, and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trail premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance theft, damage, or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the eligibility imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage caused of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Instructions

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (Black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (non exceeding 13 in., over 13 in but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth)
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show or which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 15, Section 3.)
